

# Easy-Care Dumb Cane

## Common Name:

Dumb Cane Dieffenbachia

## Botanical Name:

Dieffenbachia seguine

## Light & Temperature needs:

- Bright indirect light as long as it's not in full darkness or direct sun. The variegation indicates this plant will be healthier in brighter light.
- Household temperatures consistently best between 65° - 75°F, but okay 40°-90°F

## Water:

- Water when the top 1/2" to 1" is dry. When watering, it is important to give them a soaking so that water comes out of the bottom of the pot. Don't water again until moderately dry as above.

## Feeding information and General Care tips:

- Feed like most houseplants during our spring-summer with fertilizer diluted to half strength every other time you water.
- Or use granular slow-release fertilizer every spring for the growing season.

## Best location in home:

- Anywhere that gets some daylight everyday with moderate temperatures.
- Can grow from 3 feet up to 10 feet tall, so give it some space!

## Example of how to enjoy it:

- The Dumb Cane will happily stand in a corner set back from the window in an office, living room, dorm room or restaurant and give the eyes something green to look at indoors year round.
